This award rewards the skill of the bathroom designer in aesthetic and practical results, but also the use of budget, problem solving and exceeding the client's brief.



From the outset, Darren's design had to deal with the customer's unusual requirements. For a start, the kitchen was upstairs in a bungalow - with the tight reveals, Velux windows and sloping ceiling

that went with it. That he managed to pull off something so stylish is a great piece of work but he also incorporated some clever pull out workdesks and other interesting touches all for a total cost of £21,800.
