This award rewards designers under the age of 25 for showing their existing skills and future promise in aesthetic results, but also their use of budget and problem solving.



One of the first full kitchens that Erin has designed and she's managed to come up with something that's clever and shows how you don't have to necessarily do the same thing as everyone else. From

the beginning she decided to make a feature of the run of Miele appliances, cleverly turning them into a floating effect that juts out of the normal units. An innovation that belies her age and experience.

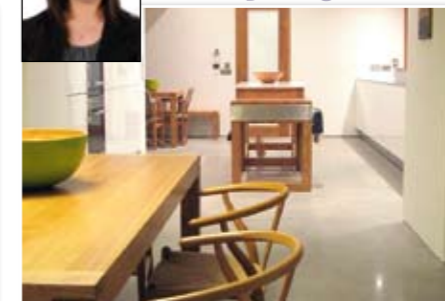

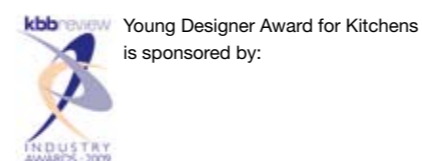
